ADVICE ON HOW TO SECURE UPVC DOORS.

There are still too many house burglaries due to UPVC doors not being locked properly. Some offences have occurred overnight and the method the suspect(s) are using is 'popping' UPVC doors which have not been double locked. **It is essential that if you have a UPVC door that you double lock it. Your UPVC door will be vulnerable if it is just shut not double locked.**



ATTEMPTED BUSINESS PREMISES

DATA PROTECTION ACT.

Yes there are changes in the Act from 25th May however they **ONLY** affect those who are new members to Neighbourhood Watch after that date as anyone who wishes to be involved with Neighbourhood Watch will be requested to complete a form to state that they are willing to have their personal contact information used **ONLY** to receive crime prevention information via Neighbourhood Watch. **You will also be required to sign the Neighbourhood Watch Code of Ethics too.**

However it is possible that some NW Co-ordinators may re-start their Groups by asking their members to sign a form and Code of Ethics too.
