TEEN CHARGED FOLLOWING AN ASSAULT

HALSTEAD

A fifteen year old male has been charged with assault causing grievous bodily harm and shop theft following an investigation by Braintree Neighbourhood Policing Team (NPT).

The charges related to an incident on 23rd March when a customer was asaulted at The Co-Op store, Colchester Road.

Officers responded swiftly and the teenager was arrested shortly after.

He is due to appear before Colchester Magistrates court 8th August.

This highlights the continued efforts of local policing teams to tackle serious incidents amd maintain safety in our communities
