CCTV FOLLOWING A BANK ROBBERY

BRAINTREE Great Square

2nd January 08:55hrs



Detectives investigating a robbery at a bank in Braintree are in a position to release an image of a man they want to identify. A man, with what has been described as a handgun, entered the Halifax bank in Great Square shortly after 8.55am on Friday 2 January. He demanded money from staff and left with an amount of cash. Through extensive CCTV enquiries, officers believe the man then left the town centre via Market Street before going down St Michaels Lane, and Notley Road. He then enters the John Ray Park from Flitch Way through the entrance near the allotments.

Detective Inspector Frazer Low said: "I appreciate this image does not clearly show the man's face but I believe someone will have seen him. "Since the incident we have explored a number of lines of investigation and continue to make a series of enquiries. "I am asking the public, especially those living in the areas surrounding the park to check any CCTV from 9am onwards. Equally anybody who recognises the man pictured, his clothing, or the bike. If you have any information, CCTV, dash cam or other footage in relation to this incident, then please get in contact with us. Please quote the crime reference number 42/873/26. You can let us know by submitting a report on our website or by using our online Live Chat service which is available 24 hours-a-day, seven days-a-week.
