## 1. Website/Facebook

### \* Report:

- During the first four months of 2022 unique visitor activity on the website has • been **18% higher** than during the same period last year. The actual number of visits is up by nearly 3%.
- A link to detailed information about the **Playing Field Development Project**, as • presented at the Parish Assembly, has been added to the 'Important Information' box on the Home page and the Playing Field page itself has also been updated: https://greatmaplesteadpc.co.uk/parish-information/amenities/playing-field/
- The Council's Facebook page continues to be a valuable asset; the **39 posts** so • far this year have reached **5,781 people**, an average of **148 per post** – the most viewed/commented was, inevitably, the **Dog Waste** post (584); the 'Bike *Ride'* posts have reached **249** people and the least viewed was the **Warmer** Homes for Essex (40). Make of that what you will! These figures do not include the reach of the majority of the Council posts shared on Maplestead Mates although the 'Bike Ride' posts there reached a total of 907 people in April.
