Chairman's Report - November 2024

Areas of Responsibility

Footpaths

Report:

- Clearance of the fallen tree blocking the access of FP29 from Dynes Hall Road was carried out by the landowner at the end of August and the clearance of the lower section of FP23 was carried out in mid-September.
- The condition of the footbridge in the Slype Copse on FP26 has been causing concern for a while, with some decking planks becoming loose and unable (due to rotten ends) to be safely re-fixed. ECC have inspected it but cannot schedule any repairs until after March 2025. However, we have been offered a 'repair kit' (new bearers, planks and fixings) to enable a Task Force fix this material is due to be delivered on Thursday 28th November.

♦ Action Plan:

- Arrange a work party to effect repairs/replacement of decking on the FP26 footbridge in early December.
- Monitoring checks continue on FPs11 & 15 to determine when action needed.
