# Playing Field Development Project [Agenda Item 8.1]

## Report:

- The first part of the Project was completed at the beginning of August with the installation of new picnic benches and construction of the Boules Court – the latter also contributed to providing an earth bund, a long-promised additional security measure around the car park.
- The 'Playing Field Fun(d) Day' on the afternoon of 14<sup>th</sup> August, held to mark the Project's official launch, was judged a great success. It attracted a large number of visitors, many from the wider reaches of Essex and Suffolk.
- As well as being a fundraiser, the **fête** was also intended to be a way of generating greater awareness of the proposals for the playing field's redevelopment; there was a display where residents were able to study the plans and discuss fund-raising ideas.
- The Fun(d) Day contributed over £1400 towards the Project, which will help boost match-funding for other grants, which are now being actively sought.
- A 'Totaliser Tree' is now on display on the field to chart fundraising progress.

#### Action Plan:

- A CIF grant for £10,000 is being prepared for submission to Essex CC and a request has been made to our County Councillor for his support.
- A number of other approaches to grant providers are being actively pursued.
- Tenders for submitting to manufacturers of natural playground-style equipment are also at the preparation stage.
- A request is being made to Stewart Landscapes for a disabled access path cost estimate to see what effect that additional item will have of the Project's budget.
